Nursing practices: put the science and art of nursing in to action.



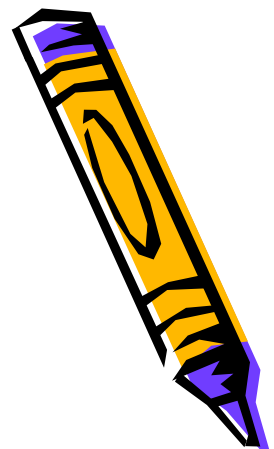
Canadian Association for Nurses (CAN)

Nursing practices requires a combination of:

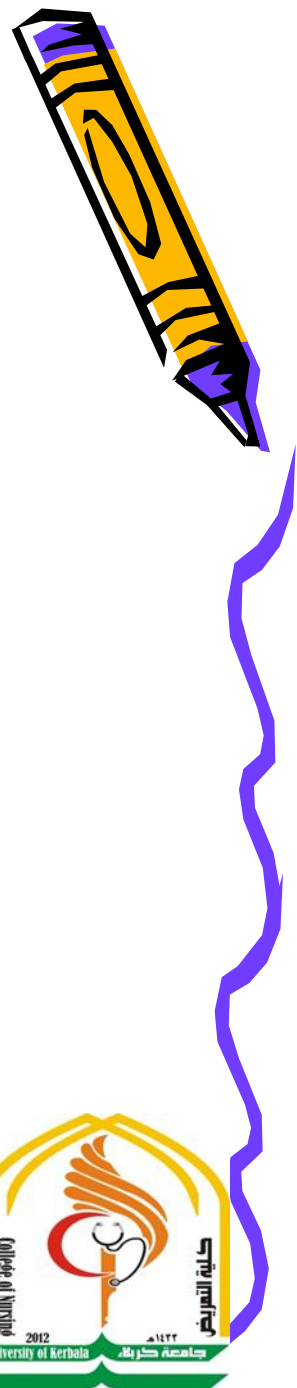
- 1- Intellectual achievement.

Standards of professional nursing:

Is a behavior that upholds the status methods, character, and standards of given profession.

Characteristics of profession: These characteristics which distinguish nursing from occupation.

1- Services provided are vital to human beings & welfare of society.

2- There exists a special body of knowledge that تخضعundergoes continual growth & research

3- The services provided involve intellectual activities and individual responsibility or accountability.

4- nurses receive education in institution of higher learning.



5- Nurses have autonomy and control their own policies and activities.

6- Nurses are motivated by service they provide and consider their work an important to their lives (altruism)

8- High standards of practice are encouraged & supported by an organization.



The Elements that emerging profession:

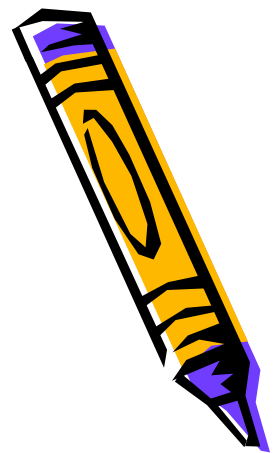
- 1- Quality of altruism. الايثار الحقيقي.

The Criteria which recognized nursing as a profession:

- 1- Well-defined body of specific knowledge.
- 2- Strong services orientation.
- 3- Recognized authority by a professional group.
- 4- Code of ethics.
- 5- Professional organization that sets standards.
- 6- Ongoing research.
- 7- Autonomy

standards of clinical nursing practices

A. Standards of care:

Standards 1: Assessment The nurse collect patients health data.

Standards 2: Diagnosis: the nurse analyzes the assessment data in determining nursing diagnosis.

Standards 3: Outcome identification: the nurse identifies expected outcome Individualized to the pt.



Standards 4: Planning: The nurse develops a plan of care that prescribe intervention to attain expected outcomes.

Standards 5: Implementation: the nurse implements the interventions identified in the Plan of care.

Standards 6: Evaluation: the nurse evaluates of the pts. Progress toward attainment outcomes.



B- Standards of professional performance

Standards 1: Quality of care: the nurse systematically evaluates the quality and Effectiveness of nursing practice.

Standards 2: performance appraisal: the nurse evaluate ones own nursing practice in relation to professional practice standards and relevant statutes and regulation.

Standards 3: Education: acquires and maintains current knowledge and competency in nursing practice.



Standards 4: Collegiality

the nurse interacts with and contributes to the professional development of peers and other health care providers as colleagues

Standards 5: Ethics: the Nurse's decision and action on behalf of pts. Are determined in an ethical manner.
